Job responsibilities will include developing and managing grassroots and grassroots activities with partners in the field, identifying opportunities to promote our message and engage new allies, contributing to and coordinating communications plans, and weaving together participation from a broad range of national, state and local organizations.

Ideal candidates will have a strong commitment to economic justice; at least 5 years of campaign, organizing, and / or communications experience; the ability to provide leadership, drive results, and to collaborate effectively with staff and partners; an interest in thinking through strategies that both strengthen existing organizations and contribute effectively to shared goals; facility talking and writing about complex policy issues clearly and compellingly; a good ear for compelling messages; and be good multitaskers, and comfortable working in a fast paced and diverse environment. The job offers opportunities for more experienced candidates to take on greater levels of responsibility.

AFR is a coalition of more than 200 consumer, labor, civil rights, senior, community, business, academic, and other groups working together to hold Wall Street accountable and to transform our financial system so that it serves our families and our communities. AFR played a leading role in strengthening and winning passage of the Dodd Frank financial reform law, and is now fighting for tough implementation of that legislation, and for broader changes to our financial system.
