These career opportunities will place you directly in a fast-paced work environment where you will continually increase your knowledge and improve your skill set by working on a variety of projects.

Responsibilities for the Multimedia Internship will include:

- Execute a results-driven social media strategy by developing and curating engaging content for social media platforms
- Work with the Digital Director and Department to update/maintain our social media calendar and develop engaging content
- Stay up-to-date on the latest social media best practices, trends and technologies
- Maintain a unified brand voice across different social media channels

- Interact with users and respond to social media messages, inquiries, and comments
- Report on comments and feedback from users
- Collaborate with Policy, Research and Campaign teams on social media content
- Provide general administrative support to the Digital Director and the Digital Department and complete other tasks as needed
- Maintain social media platforms including Facebook, YouTube, Instagram, Twitter, LinkedIn.
- Develop, research, film, storyboard, produce, and edit video and animated multimedia products for various platforms, including long form and social media content that will further AFR's work to engage and educate our followers
